- See if you can find the following Australian Mammals?

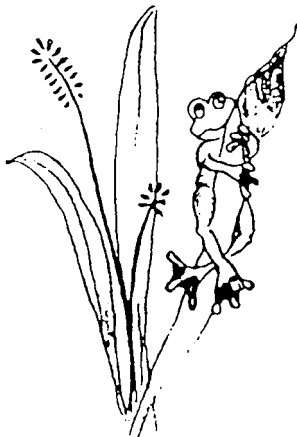
