- To divest yourself of land that you can no longer selectively log because of its World Heritage status
- To be able to continue selective logging in the remaining parts of State Forest 268 adjacent to the Wet Tropics World Heritage Area
- To be provided with the resources, both human and financial, that will allow you to effectively manage the area of Mt Spec State Forest that will remain under your control
- Parks and Wildlife to maintain infrastructure like roads in a condition suitable for use by the timber industry

## WET TROPICS WORLD HERITAGE AREA MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

You want

- The public to appreciate the World Heritage values of the Wet Tropics through the provision of interpretive facilities
- To work with Parks and Wildlife in protecting the World Heritage values of both their existing and new land tenures
- To make available to Queensland Parks and Wildlife limited funding to enable these things to happen
