Our initiatives include


- Providing an extension opportunity for students by supporting the implementation of The Australian Curriculum: English and the General Capability: Literacy

- Providing an opportunity for professional learning and skill development for accompanying staff through working with a published children's author and local artist/illustrator

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Engaging a published, Australian children's author to deliver workshops for students and supervising teachers throughout the excursion
- Engaging a local artist / art teacher to assist with student illustrations and provide guidance and professional development for supervising teachers to enhance practice in classroom settings
- Providing materials/resources and printing finished student works
